

### THE INDEPENDENTE HOSTEL & SUITES · LISBON, PORTUGAL

Originally built to become the Swiss ambassador's official residence at the start of the 20th century, this fantastically located palace – right in the centre of the Bairro Alto and Principe Real districts - assumed a new life as it celebrated its centenary.

Its 90 beds spread across 11 dorms with its impressive floor to ceiling heights and abundant size, offer guests the opportunity to enjoy a private lounge within every room where they can relax and share stories and experiences with fellow travellers. Our three-story bunk beds, custom made for the Hostel, include built in secure storage and will make you feel like you're on top of the world!

Our Guest Relations team organises weekly events, ranging from movie nights to cooking shows so that you'll always have something to do. We also host regular concerts from local and international artists and partnerships with local specialised guides, surf tours and many other fun activities.

The Independente Hostel & Suites also offers a fully licensed bar and restaurant as well as a secluded beer garden for hot summer days. The typically Portuguese cuisine with a modern twist set amongst an art-déco environment open to both the international and local public.

Set between Chiado and Príncipe Real, two of Lisbon's trendiest neighbourhoods, this 19th century palace is both elegant and bohemian, the perfect place for an indulgent yet authentic stay.

Coming to life a few years after its twin brother next door, The Independente Hostel and Suites, The Independente Suites and Terrace offers a different but no less creative accommodation concept. Built with comfort in mind, all 22 rooms are ensuite, with cable television, sustainable A/C system, Nespresso coffee machines and ridiculously cushy beds! There is free wifi in the rooms and every morning, breakfast is served on our rooftop terrace with one of the best views of the city!

Guests have access to an exclusive guest lounge, located in the building next door, where they can join in on several events, from poker night to cooking classes, all organised by our Guest Relations team.

From the colourful lobby, to the handpicked items spread through-out, not to mention the artworks from 18 artists from the Independent artist salon in the early 20th century, and the breath-taking view in the rooftop restaurant, this building is full of unexpected delights that will surely make your Lisbon stay unforgettable.

Keeping in line with the restaurant concept, our bar serves 100% Portuguese signature cocktails – made exclusively with spirits produced in Portugal, by Portuguese brands.


At The Insólito you will find a place to rediscover flavours and textures, sometimes through the least expected combinations.

On the first floor, where once was the tasting room, you will be greeted by friendly staff members by the welcome desk, located in the bar-lounge. The epicentre of the social living of the building, this is the meeting place for travellers, and also where the hostel's private wine cellar and kitchen is located. Here, guests can enjoy homemade dinners, game nights, concerts by local bands and several other exciting activities.

Inside one of the four spacious dorms you will find custom-made king-sized single beds, with an outrageous design inspired by the Port Wine barrels. You also get ensuite private and fully equipped bathrooms. The granite stone walls and the huge windows serve as reminders of the building's industrial past, while the corklines entrance hall and the colourful bathroom tiles give it a warm and familiar vibe

If you prefer a more private experience you can choose from any of our 12 large suites, overlooking the Douro river and Porto's beautiful riverfront, decorated with pieces inspired by Sandeman's irreverent and avant-guard spirit, and your very own turntable and vinyl records!

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## THE INDY HOUSE ROOMS AND APARTMENTS' LISBON, PORTUGAL



The Indy House features 34 rooms, 1 suite, 5 one-bedroom apartment and 1 twobedroom apartment, along with 7 shared kitchens, as well as 2 common rooms and a patio. An experience in creative hospitality, The Indy House allows guests to define the rhythm of their stay, with nothing but the essentials for a pleasant visit.

Breakfast is available from 7.30 until noon every day in the shared kitchens, so guests decide when and what they would like to have; no rush, no set menu, just all you need for a perfect start of the day. The rooms are comfortable and carefully decorated with details that will keep surprising you with ever new look. The ample common rooms invite you to stay and chat to other travellers and recharge your creativity.

In the same building, The Favela presents a unique venue for any type of private, totally customisable events. The Favela can accommodate a maximum of 100 people, with covered and outdoor areas. The decoration is like nothing you have ever seen, with a huge mural artwork by Lisbon artists Estúdio Altura taking up the whole exterior wall and old doors and windows piled up to create a wall. Here you can experience an with an exotic and vibrant vibe, like a tiny oasis in the heart of the city .

At The Indy House, you will get to experience the city on the side-lines of the tour guides, where life happens in a wave of creativity and multiculturality.
